Introduction

This list, including the known salticids of Canada, the continental United States, and Mexico, is based on current literature and on earlier lists (Richman & Cutler, 1978, 1988), as well as previously unpublished records available to the authors. We have not included specific page and illustration numbers. Reference dates (*e.g.*, 1904*b*) generally correspond to those listed in Platnick (2011), although not all references (*e.g.*, Paquin *et al.*, 2010) can be found in his catalog. We have tried to mention primarily key references and those with good descriptions and/or illustrations, but have not included all references for those species with multiple synonyms, especially if they have numerous Old World citations.

Canadian Provinces, United States state names, and Mexican state names are abbreviated, with the Canadian localities based on the Canada Post abbreviations, United States localities based on the Zip Code abbreviations and for Mexico we used a list of standard abbreviations (three letters) from the Wikipedia Template site (Wikipedia 2011) on the Internet (Table 1, Figure 1). The distributions are, of course, necessarily incomplete and should be revised periodically. Hawaii, which has its own relatively limited native and introduced fauna, is not included.

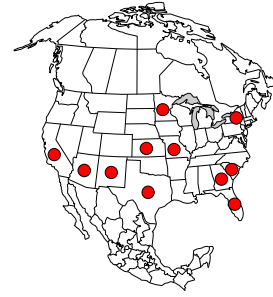

This species belongs to the mostly South American *Sassacus arcuatus* Group and as such is almost certainly not a true *Sassacus*. This needs to be resolved. At least one other species of this group is known from Mexico, based on a specimen from the American Museum of Natural History in New York.

Discussion

For reference, changes to the previous version of this document are listed in Appendix 1.

This list is not final. The authors know of at least a dozen undescribed species for the United States and there are probably many more in Mexico. There may even be a few in Canada, although their fauna is smaller. The genera *Pellenes*, *Peckhamia*, and *Phanias* need to be revised, and there are several undescribed species in the genera *Habronattus*, *Maevia* and *Pelegrina*. One ant-like genus from Molino Basin in the Santa Catalina Mountains of Pima County, Arizona is also undescribed. As noted in the list, many species are still misplaced with respect to genus. In addition, we can expect many new reports related to the distribution of known species in the future, in part the result of human transport, the rapid climate change that is pushing biomes to the north during this interglacial period, and a greater level of general interest in the Salticidae as a group.

For illustrations of North American salticids, many resources, including Wikipedia entries, can now be obtained just by searching for respective scientific names on the Internet. Specifically, we recommend sites referenced below under BugGuide (2011), Maddison (1994), Metzner (2011), and Prószyński (2011). Edwards & Hill (2008) also provide a good illustrated introduction to the most important genera, as well as references to most of the recent revisions of these genera.
